Just a few reminders:

Please be sure to check ICICILL and ICICILL email **every day**. This is extremely important. We do not want any “expired” requests from libraries in our system. This happens when you don’t respond to requests in ICICILL within 3 days. Also, please check your ICICILL calendar (under “settings”) to be sure your library is marked closed for all breaks and holidays.

When sending out books and other materials as the lender for ILLs, you must include the pull slip. If you don’t know how to print

pull slips, please call me and I will walk you through the process.

The orange bags used to transport books **MUST** be labeled with “J3J” or “School Library System” on the outside if they are going to any library outside of our Jefferson-Lewis BOCES SLS area. (Inside can then be labeled with borrowing library’s information.) Our van drivers do not understand the codes for libraries (public or school) outside the Jefferson-Lewis BOCES SLS area. If you are unsure about whether or not a school library is in our JL BOCES area, please check the directory. Our schools are under the system heading “JLHO”.

Speaking of the directory, everyone knows where to find this North Country Library Regional Directory, don’t they?
